

Add Dependents Request Form for F-1 students

International students who wish to bring dependents (spouse and child/ren) in the US should request an I-20 issued for every dependent. The financial information in SEVIS (Student and Exchange Visitor Information System) will be updated to reflect expenses needed to provide for the dependents while completing the full 12 credit hour course load. If the dependent is a US citizen or a permanent resident, there is no need to request an I-20. Once the I-20 for each dependent is issued, the F-1 student needs to sign it on page 1, section 11. **Meet with the International Student Services Coordinator to submit the request.**
